Symposium: Earth's Climate Change: Science and Impacts

Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts, Belgrade, Serbia

October 11-13, 2017

Climate change observation, Earth system modeling, paleoclimate, limited area modeling, and climate change impact scientists are kindly invited to a three-day symposium "Earth's Climate Change: Science and Impacts," organized by the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts, October 11-13, 2017, in Belgrade, Serbia. Sessions will be held on what recent observations are telling us, Earth climate system modeling issues, lessons for the future we have from past climate, such as from the Eemian interglacial period, regional climate modeling, addressing Mediterranean / South-eastern Europe in particular, and climate change impact we can expect on vital issues of water, agriculture, energy, economy, health.

The issues to be dealt with include

- What is the state-of-the-art of climate change modeling, and what do the modern observations and climate change projection results tell us?
- How can we complement or amend our projections using paleoclimate data and studies? In other words, what are past climate lessons for the future?
- What specifically are near-term climate futures of south-eastern Europe / Mediterranean, and what are or should be the methodologies best used for such regional projections? What are the assessments of their impacts on vital issues of water, energy, agriculture, forestry, sustainability, economy, environment, health, other?

Contributions in accordance with the symposium topics outlined above, both oral and poster, are welcome. Abstracts or extended abstracts in English language, up to a maximum of six pages, including figures, tables or diagrams, are invited to be submitted to the Secretariat of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts by **August 15**. Abstracts and registration form must be submitted electronically to **climatechange2017(at)sanu.ac.rs**. Authors are requested to download and follow the format given in the posted abstract template. The symposium Program and/or Organizing Committee will review the submitted abstracts, and the authors will be notified of possible acceptance before **September 17, 2017**. The official language of the conference is English. **The number of participants may be limited**, so it is advisable to register early. There will be **no registration fee**.

Depending on the interest, an excursion to the renovated family home of Milutin Milanković, in Dalj, Croatia, now a Cultural and Scientific Center, with an appropriate program, will be organized Saturday, October 14.
